SUBJECT: FULFILMENT OF MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF THE PHARM. D PROGRAM

Reference to the subject cited above.

2. Pharmacy Council of Pakistan is regulating the pharmacy education, pharmacy facilities (infrastructure, faculty, financial resources, syllabus, examinations), pharmacists, pharmacy support personnel, etc. in the country and it is a professional body responsible for the registration of pharmacists and promotion of pharmacy education.

3. It has been brought into attention that various Universities/ Institutions which are running Pharm. D Program do not fulfill the minimum requirements of the degree program anymore and consistently violating terms & conditions of the NOC, issued by Pharmacy Council of Pakistan. Therefore, the verification of the required facilities, infrastructure, faculty and other requirements of pharmacy education is indispensable in order to maintain the standards and quality of education.

4. In view of the foregoing, you are required to ensure the fulfilment of minimum requirements of the Pharm. D program in your University/ Institution at the earliest. A team comprising of inspectors of Pharmacy Council of Pakistan may inspect your premises/attached hospital at any time without prior intimation. Failure to comply with the directions of the Council will lead to revocation of NOC for Pharm. D program.

A team comprising of inspectors of Pharmacy Council of Pakistan may inspect your premises/attached hospital at any time without prior intimation. Failure to comply with the directions of the Council will lead to revocation of NOC for Category-B program.
