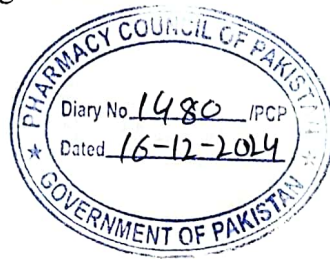
SUBJECT: STOPPAGE OF ADMISSIONS IN PHARM. D PROGRAM FOR
SESSION 2024-29 - BAKHTAWAR AMIN COLLEGE OF
PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, MULTAN

Reference to the subject cited above.

2. It is to inform that Pharmacy Council of Pakistan in its 61st meeting held on December 2, 2024 under Agenda Item No. 7 has decided as below;

“The Council after detailed discussion unanimously endorsed the decision of the Council as previously communicated vide letters dated October 27, 2022 and decided to restrain the University of Health Sciences, Lahore from granting affiliation till the own accreditation under Section 18 and 19 of the Pharmacy Act, 1967. Moreover, it was decided to stop induction of intake of students by Bakhtawar Amin College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Multan and Quaid-e-Azam College of Pharmacy, Sahiwal for Session 2024-29 till affiliation by a Public Sector University duly recognized by the Council. In was also decided that, in future, no institute shall be allowed to change its affiliating University without prior approval of the Council.”

3. In view of the above, you are hereby directed to stop intake in Pharm. D program w.e.f Session 2024-29. Moreover, you are required to submit complete dossier along with prescribed fee for the change of affiliation.
