Reference is drawn to the subject captioned above.

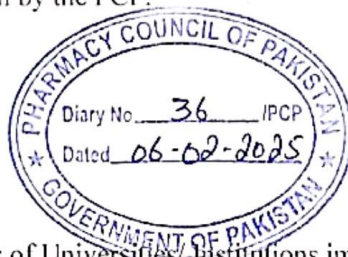
2. The Pharmacy Council of Pakistan, by virtue of Section 17 of the Pharmacy Act, 1967, read with Pharm D Regulations, 2005, and PCP (Qualification for appointment of Teachers) Regulations, 2015, is mandated with the function of regulating pharmacy education in Pakistan, particularly focusing on maintaining the standard of pharmacy education across the country.

3. The hiring and having appropriate faculty, in accordance with prescribed parameters, is a critical factor in maintaining educational standards in any institution. Therefore, to ensure that all approved/recognized institutions are operating with the requisite faculty, it is hereby required that the following information regarding faculty be submitted by all institutions:

The requisite information should reach the office of the undersigned at the earliest but not later than **Feb 17, 2025** without any fail so that the same can be uploaded on the website of Pharmacy Council of Pakistan both in hard form and in excel sheet at [pcpbluearea@gmail.com](mailto:pcpbluearea@gmail.com). It is also advised that every institute must have an active website where all relevant details, inter alia, that of faculty, number of allocated seats must be uploaded for information of students, parents and other stakeholders.
