SUBJECT: INSPECTIONS OF PHARMACY INSTITUTIONS TO VERIFY THE REQUIRED FACILITIES

Reference to the subject cited above.

- 2. This is to convey that the Pharmacy Council of Pakistan has scheduled inspections of pharmacy institutions offering Pharm.D and Category B programs w.e.f 29th September. 2025. All the pharmacy institutions shall be subjected to routine and surprise inspections by the authorized teams of the Pharmacy Council of Pakistan. The purpose of these inspections is to assess compliance with statutory requirements, prescribed standards, and approved curricula.
- Inspections will focus on, but shall not be limited to the following:
 - i. Faculty qualifications, workload, and student/ teacher ratio as per PCP criteria.
 - ii. Availability/adequacy of labs, libraries, classrooms, and teaching resources.
 - iii. Clinical training arrangements and hospital affiliations.
 - iv. Student admissions/enrollment as per NOC.
 - v. Records of examinations, attendance, and academic progress.
 - vi. Compliance with minimum infrastructure as per PCP guidelines.
- 4. The strict measures will be taken by the Pharmacy Council of Pakistan on the recommendations of inspection teams including revocation of NOCs in case non-compliance to the Council's regulations/ guidelines is observed.
